SUMMER (JJA) 2013 AIR TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION ANOMALIES FOR MACEDONIA

Average seasonal air temperature for summer (Jun, July and August) 2013 over the territory of Republic of Macedonia was above normal. The seasonal air temperature anomalies in reference to 1961-1990 have been in range from $0.9\,^{\circ}$ C for Kriva Palanka and Berovo and $1.6\,^{\circ}$ C for Demir Kapija.

The warmest summer month was August. Air temperature anomalies in reference to 1961-1990 have been in range from 1.6 $^{\circ}$ C for Berovo and 3.0 $^{\circ}$ C for Demir Kapija.

The seasonal precipitation amounts over most of the territory of Republic of Macedonia were below normal and above normal for Berovo, Strumica and Lazaropole. Compared with the period 1961-1990, the precipitation anomalies have been in range from -69.2 mm for Kriva Palanka and 79.4 mm for Berovo.

The lowest precipitation amounts were registered in August. Precipitation anomalies in reference to 1961-1990 have been in range from -34.7 mm for Kriva Palanka and 6.7 mm for Lazaropole.
