

Seasonal forecast for the summer season 2014 in Bulgaria

The latest summer outlook for Bulgaria was issued at the end of April. There was no suggested dominant likelihood for any of the three categories below, near or above normal for both mean seasonal temperature and seasonal rainfall. The two tables below illustrate the latest, but still provisional, forecast from May. It favors near or above normal precipitation in average for the country. In terms of temperature however near normal (or no signal) is given. Nevertheless, summer 2014 in Bulgaria should be less warm and with more precipitation than summer 2013.
