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VERIFICATION OF THE SEECOF-33 SUMMER 2025 CLIMATE OUTLOOK FOR THE TERRITORY OF GEORGIA

1. SEECOF-33 Climate outlook for the 2025 summer season:

Temperature: According to the SEECOF-33 consensus, the statement temperature was expected to be above normal (70 %) for all over Georgia. Verification showed that the summer period in the most part of the country temperature was above and near the norm.

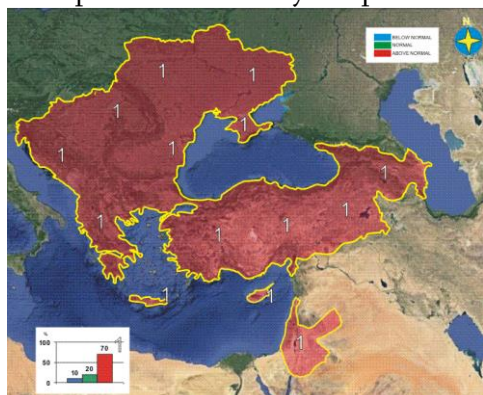


Figure 1. Graphical presentation of the 2025 summer temperature outlook

2. Analysis of the 2025 summer season:

summer temperatures (reference period 1991-2020)

In summer mean seasonal temperature was above by 1°C and near the normal in almost all of the country.

June was the coolest period during the summer by 1-2 below the norm. July and August was 1-2 above the norm on the most part of the country in several station it was near the norm.

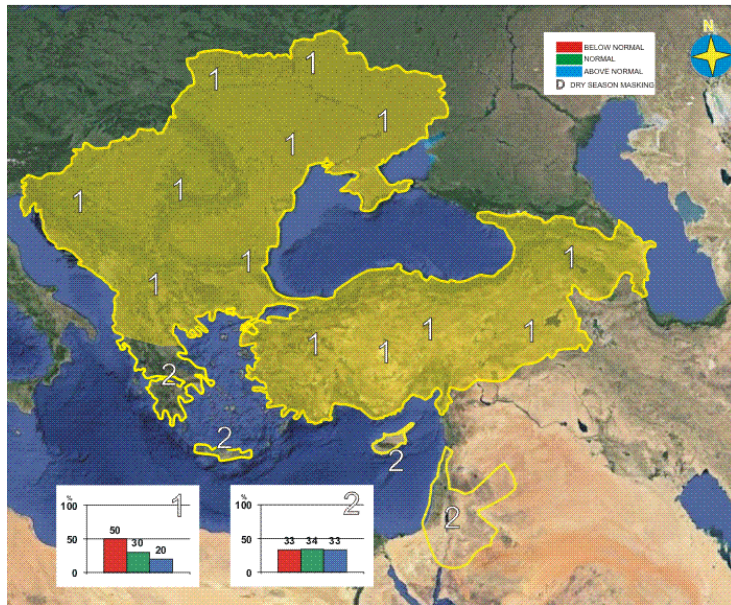


Figure 2. Graphical presentation of the 2025 summer precipitation outlook
