
Analysis of air temperature and precipitation for summer of 2011

Air temperature in summer season ranged from 15.3°C (in Žabljak) to 27.3°C (in Podgorica). Air temperature deviations were positive and ranged between 1.9°C (in Nikšić) and 3.3°C (in Rožaje).

Average seasonal air temperature have been above long term average. According to the distribution of percentile ranges, over the most part of the territory have been in **extremely warm** category **and very warm**.

The amount of rainfall during summer ranged from 35mm (in Ulcinj) to 262mm (in Pljevlja). The percentage of the amount realized from the climate normal is between 24% (H.Novi) to 113% (in Pljevlja).

According to the distribution of percentile ranges, over the most part of the country have been in **dry** category, while in the **normal** category was the northern and eastern parts of the country.
