## CLIMATE REPORT FOR MACEDONIA

## SUMMER (JJA) 2011 AIR TEMPERATURE AND PRECIPITATION ANOMALIES FOR MACEDONIA

Average seasonal air temperature for summer (Jun, July and August) 2011 over the territory of Republic of Macedonia was above normal. The seasonal air temperature anomalies in reference to 1961-1990 have been in range from 0.9 ° C for Kriva Palanka and 1.9°C for Mayrovi Anovi.

The warmest summer month was August. Air temperature anomalies in reference to 1961-1990 have been in range from 1.6  $^{\circ}$  C for Kriva Palanka and 2.6  $^{\circ}$  C for Demir Kapija.

The seasonal precipitation amounts over the territory of Republic of Macedonia were mainly below normal with the exception of some parts (Prilep and Berovo). Compared with the period 1961-1990, the precipitation anomalies have been in range from -7.0 mm for Lazaropole and -82.4mm for Gevgelija.

The lowest precipitation amounts were registered in July and August.
