I have the pleasure to inform you that the eighth session of the South-East European Climate Outlook Forum (SEECOF-8) will be held from 27 to 29 November 2012 in Podgorica, Montenegro, hosted by the Institute of Hydrometeorology. Information regarding the local arrangements is provided in the attached Information Note (SEECOF-8, INF. 1).

The main objective of the session is the collaborative production of a consensus statement on the regional climate outlook for the coming winter season 2012/2013. Experts from WMO leading climate centres will help to facilitate the work the session. The working language of the session will be English. The Provisional Agenda is attached (SEECOF-8, Doc. 1).

You are kindly requested to nominate an expert to attend the session by sending us the duly filled in and signed Nomination Form (attached). The nominated expert should be among those in your organization involved in the preparation of long-range (monthly and/or seasonal) forecasts. You may also wish to consider nominating a representative of the users of seasonal forecasts in your country, in order to facilitate a dialogue towards a better mutual understanding. However, please note that WMO will not be in a position to provide financial support to such additional experts.

As the funds available for this meeting are limited, we would appreciate it if the cost of participation of your climate expert could be covered by your organization. However, if this is not possible, the WMO Secretariat will consider the possibility of providing partial financial support (please note the support options in the Nomination Form) for one expert, upon request.
