## Analysis of temperature and precipitation for the summer 2012 in Macedonia

Summer 2012 was the warmest summer on record over the territory of Macedonia.

During summer 2012 the mean air temperature ranged from 18,4 °C in Lazaropole to 27,8 °C in Gevgelija. Temperature anomalies from normal values relating to the period (1961-1990) were positive in all stations and ranged from 2,8° C in Berovo (eastern Macedonia) to 4,0° C in Gevgelija (south-eastern Macedonia).

The warmest summer month was July. During summer 2012, maximum daily temperature for Macedonia was recorded in Demir Kapija on August 7 and it measured 43,9° C.

Summer precipitation sum for 2012 was below average, exception is one station in eastern Macedonia (Berovo), where it was above normal. Anomalies from the average amount of precipitation ranged from -104,9mm (Lazaropole) to 20,8mm (Berovo).
